

DYNAMIC LIGHTING From SoCalMotoGear

Some of you may remember the "Sequential Turn Signals" on the backs of certain older T-Birds & Cougars. Here is a modern day take on that idea which really stands out. Powerful white running lights for the front of your GL1800 or FB6 change to an eye catching moving amber when the turn signals are activated. See them in action [here!](#)



Installation involves removing the mirrors and existing front lights from the mirror housings to install and connect the new lights. Additionally, the front panel under the windshield needs to be removed to connect wires from one side to the other. If you have not already installed LED turn signals on your ride further disassembly of the fairing, including removal of the windshield, will be needed to install an LED flasher.

Available in your choice of clear or smoke lenses. The base kit lists for \$269.95 and comes with everything needed for 2006-2017 GL1800s. 2001-2005 models require an additional \$18 harness. The harness for the FB6 costs \$24.95. More information is available [here.](#)
